Public Transport Near Venue

Tramlines 5, 33, 43, 44 run very close to campus. Tramlines 37, 38, 40, 41, 42 (stop Schwarzspanierstraße) run to within 10m walking distance. The nearest U-Bahn is Schottentor, about 15 Minutes walk from campus (slow gait).
